

### 6-Month Annual Report

Beginning in July 2021, Feed My People Food Bank moved from reporting on a calendar year to a fiscal year of July 1 – June 30. This annual report reflects the interim 6-month period during the transition from calendar year reporting to new fiscal year reporting.

## During the first six months of 2021, Feed My People Food Bank expanded and stregthened programming.

- Continued weekly distribution out of the Feed My People warehouse to feed more families.
- Provided safe method of distribution for our volunteers, staff, and guests by adapting to changing health and safety strategies.
- Worked strategically with schools to best support specific needs within their student populations. The school pantry program became a significant avenue of distributing food to both students and their families.
- Supported partner pantries, meal sites, and more as they strive to do more in their communities during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
